Post-Election Balance of Power:

Governor: Daniel J McKee (D) serving his first full term as Governor.

State Senate: 33 Democrats – 5 Republicans

State House: 65 Democrats – 9 Republicans – 1 Independent

Speaker of the House: Joseph Shekarchi (D)

Senate President: Dominick Ruggiero (D)

For 2023 and 2024, both chambers will have a supermajority of Democrats and all statewide General Officer positions will be held by Democrats. The 2023 session begins on January 3, 2023.
